Background:

The CPSUs and Government of India organisations like NTPC, NHPC, CIL, IREDA, Indian Railways, etc. are coming forward to set up solar power projects. The scheme has a provision of VGF support of Rs.1000 crore for setting up of Gridconnected solar PV power projects of 1000 MW aggregate capacity to be developed by CPSUs under various Central/State Schemes by using cells and modules made in India. Requisite funds for provision of the VGF support will be made available to MNRE from the National Clean Energy Fund operated by Ministry of Finance.

Implementation of scheme for development of Solar Parks and Ultra Mega Solar Power Projects

The Union Cabinet, chaired by the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, today approved the scheme for setting up 25 solar parks each with a capacity of 500 MW and above and Ultra Mega Solar Power Projects in various parts of the country where large chunks of land can be spared for this purpose.

These parks will be able to accommodate over 20,000 MW of solar power projects. The Solar Parks/ Ultra Mega Solar Power Projects will be set up during five years that is from 2014-15 to 2018-19 and will require Central Government financial support of Rs.4050 crore. Smaller parks in Himalayan and other hilly States where contiguous land may be difficult to acquire in view of the difficult terrain, will also be considered.

The solar parks will be developed in collaboration with State Governments and their agencies. The choice of implementing agency for developing and maintaining the park is left to the State Government. The States, applying under the scheme, will have to designate an agency for the development of the solar park.

The State Government will first nominate the implementing agency for the solar park and also identify the land for the proposed solar park. It will then send a proposal to the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE) for approval along with (or later) the name of the implementing agency. The implementing agency may be sanctioned a grant of upto Rs.25 Lakh for preparing a Detailed Project Report (DPR) of the Solar Park, conducting surveys, etc. The DPR must be



NE states of India may get 100% Govt fund for solar projects: MNRE minister



If everything falls in place, the North Eastern states of India could get 100 per cent fund for setting up solar power projects, according to the union minister of new and renewable energy (MNRE), Dr. Farooq Abdulla.

Replying to a supplementary question in the Rajya Sabha, Dr. Abdullah said that the Centre was likely to clear the proposal for hundred per cent funding of solar power projects in the North East, with the MNRE endorsing the demand of the power ministers of the region.

The north eastern states get 90 per cent assistance from the Government of India for setting up solar projects. Recently, Dr. Abdullah had met the power ministers of the north east who had demanded that the center should increase the funding of

solar projects from 90 per cent to 100 percent, as they were not in a position to even bear 10 per cent of

Dr. Abdullah informed the House that he has already put the matter before the Prime Minister and the Finance Minister saying that for the north eastern states, the assistance from the Centre should be increased to 100 per cent, to enhance the growth of the renewable energy sector in the region.

The minister said that the basic reason for providing assistance to the north east is because a number of areas in those regions are ones, where transmission lines have not reached, and it would take a long time for the same to happen.

The minister said that his ministry was not only helping north east but other parts of the country as well. He said that the government has various plans and programs, however, the matter of concern in India is the higher cost of production for generating solar energy as compared to other countries.
